Paul Kuhns was scheduled to make a presentation to the Board about the historical society but was unable to attend. He will be invited to another meeting.

Old Business:

- The tax report for a nonprofit is done online. An EIN number is required. There is some confusion as to RBHA's EIN number. The EIN number was obtained before any of the current RBHA board members were on the Board.
- The Board reviewed a list of local organizations for potential donations with RBHA's surplus for 2010. The list includes the village improvement association, the historical society, the fire department, the police department, the City of Rehoboth Beach (for playground equipment, beach wheels, and flowers), the library, Main Street, the daycare center, Camp Rehoboth, the senior center, and Rehoboth Elementary School. Since a donation to Main Street for the fireworks was made earlier this year, Main Street was not considered for the 2010 surplus donation. The fire department is in the middle of a capital campaign, and it was felt that the fire department has the more significant need. It was proposed that we invite a representative from the fire department to speak at the annual meeting and give a donation of \$2500.00 to the fire department.
- The June newsletter has been finished and will be organized by Stan Mills before it goes to the printer.

- Constant Contact E-blast: About fifty percent of RBHA members have provided their email addresses. About 20 of these no longer work. A list of the email addresses that bounce will be sent to the treasurer for review. RBHA's email list is private and not shared.
- The list of committee and commission meetings will be updated by Stephen Angle.
- There will be no RBHA meeting in July.

New Business:

- Howard Butler will coordinate coastal cleanup. Coastal cleanup is the last Saturday in September this year.
- Judy Mellen and Steve Angle agreed to be in charge of arranging for a speaker from the fire department for the annual meeting. Suggested topics for the speaker include the evacuation plan and the fire and rescue siren system.

The meeting adjourned at 8:56 a.m. The next meeting will be August 21, 2010, at 8:00 a.m. at All Saints' Episcopal Church.
