The following letter was sent for publication in tomorrow's edition of the *Cape Gazette*. It was written because of inquiries, as noted in the letter.

Editor:

I am writing this letter as President of the Rehoboth Beach Homeowners' Association (RBHA). I am deeply concerned that a recent advertisement in the Cape Gazette and a mailed letter from Save Our City implies an endorsement of two candidates for the upcoming City Commissioner election by the RBHA. I have had several phone calls and inquiries as to our 'support' of these two candidates.

I need to state emphatically that the RBHA DOES NOT support the two candidates running on the Save Our City platform. WE ARE NOT a Political Action Committee as they are and as such, DO NOT support candidates. Our By-Laws clearly state that we do not and can not support candidates. The Association makes a conscious effort to avoid the appearance of this conflict of interest due to the overwhelming position of our organization being representative of the entire City of Rehoboth Beach residential and business community alike.

The upcoming election is an important one and I can not permit any implied support to affect the election process through use of our Association in anyway and need the record to reflect that.
