

SEPTEMBER 8 BOARD MEETING

The RBHA Board met on Saturday, September 8th. President Kauffman announced that the Annual General Membership meeting will be held Saturday, October 20, 2007 at 10:00 am. The business portion of the meeting will focus on filling one vacant Director's position. All members are eligible and invited to throw their hats in the ring. There's a 30 day notice requirement, so we'll need to hear from you by no later than September 19, 2007. A speaker will be invited; there will be more information on that soon. The Treasurer's report noted that there is \$9,403.15 in the various accounts. Membership Committee Chair Marcia Maldies said that we currently have 432 members.

Hoyte Decker reported on his efforts to rework the RBHA Website. Under New Business Membership criteria was considered. A copy will be published in the Newsletter, which is about to go to the printer; the budget will be formally presented to the general membership at the Annual Meeting.
